Our Facilities:

Harmon Park is home to Bucyrus Area Youth Soccer. Located on North Lane St (just north of Kroger) Harmon Park currently has a playground and 7 soccer fields ranging from full size soccer fields to small under-9 soccer fields. We have the benefit and scheduling flexibility of lighting on the main soccer field. This site was the former home of the Bucyrus City Schools football team. In 2008, Bucyrus Area Youth Soccer and the City of Bucyrus received grants to make improvement to the south field house. This included removing the floor and putting in new plumbing and a new floor. There are now new men's and women's bathrooms and a concession stand in the building.

Our mission is to promote soccer in the Bucyrus and surrounding areas while giving kids a fun activity that allows them to exercise and to learn teamwork.
